

Preface

The AMERICAN ARCHITECTS DIRECTORY was last published in 1962. There have been changes in many ways in the intervening eight years. Some have come about by slow evolution. Others have taken place in a very rapid manner. I am thinking not only of socio-economic events. Our tastes and ideas have also changed to varying degrees. Thus it is that this edition appears in a changed format. All change may not be good. But the editor agrees with the publisher that the new appearance is more a reflection of our new thinking.

Both the First and Second Editions were a very great contribution to the profession. Dr. George S. Koyl, FAIA, was the editor of both these editions. We owe him much. He developed a technique which produced an authoritative reference on living architects of the United States. Both editions have been widely used within the profession. They have also been valuable to industrial and commercial organizations, as well as governmental agencies, in gathering information on individual architects and architectural firms. We hope that the same may be said for the Third Edition when it has been in use.

We talk much about the population explosion. There has been an explosion of sorts in the architectural profession as well. However, we do not advocate limiting the numbers of architects. Between the original edition, in 1956, and the Second Edition, in 1962, there was an approximate increase of 50 per cent in the numbers of architects included. Between

the Second Edition and the present one there is an increase of better than 60 per cent. In the First Edition there were approximately 9,000 listings. In the present edition, better than 23,000 architects are included.

One innovation in the Third Edition has been the naming of Associate Editors. Each Chapter president has been requested to name a member in his Chapter whom the editor might contact in matters relative to the particular area. Of the one-hundred-seventy-one local Chapters all but eight cooperated. The editor is deeply obligated to each and every one of the Associate Editors for all the assistance and time that has been given in carrying out this commitment. The editor here thanks each one of this body. Their names are listed, by Chapter, immediately following the Preface.

Every Corporate Member of the American Institute of Architects is listed herein. All were requested to fill in new biographical data and furnish information on their Firms. There are also included architects who are not members of the Institute. The Associate Editors were requested to recommend those non-AIA architects who were principals or partners in architectural firms who should be included. Every architect thus recommended, who has returned the requested information is included. The editor has endeavored to include all material eligible under criteria established for this edition as presented on the "Biographical Questionnaire" and the "Firm Listing"

form. For inadvertent errors he asks the understanding indulgence of the biographees and of the profession.

The editor wishes to thank the present Chancellor of the College of Fellows, J. Roy Carroll, Jr., for the opportunity to serve in this capacity for the third edition. At the 1969 Convention in Chicago, through his efforts and leadership, the College of Fellows determined to underwrite my honorarium and my costs incurred in carrying out the efforts on this publication. Following this action by the College of Fellows, the Board of the American Institute of Architects agreed to cooperate to the full, by affording access to all possible information contained in the records and known by the staff at the Octagon. This action by the Board has been carried out to the full by each and every member of the staff with whom I have had contact. My

time spent in the AIA offices has been much greater than I had originally anticipated. However, I have only good things to say for these hours spent there. Those who aided me are too numerous to name here. But to each and every one I give my heartfelt thanks.

I must offer my thanks to another group. That is the editorial staff. The time I spent with them has been a most pleasant experience. They worked me hard and the hours were sometimes long. Yet they were always patient and cooperative.

And lastly, I offer my deep thanks to Dr. Koyl. It was his idea that started the AMERICAN ARCHITECTS DIRECTORY. It is to him that we all owe our thanks.
