While with City designed two thin plate girder bridges and one 300'-0" deck girder viaduct which are still in use. In December, 1910 started as draftsman doing detailing and designing for the Hughes-Keenan Company of Mansfield, Ohio, fabricators of structural steel and ornamental iron. In 1912 assumed complete charge of estimating, designing and drafting. In October, 1919, started in business for myself but was persuaded to become associated with Vernon Redding, Architect, and in December made this connection. In 1922 became associated with Vernon Redding and Associates, handling all structural designing and doing most of the supervision. Resigned from Vernon Redding and Associates in December 1936 and started my own office in May, 1937. (See attached sheet)

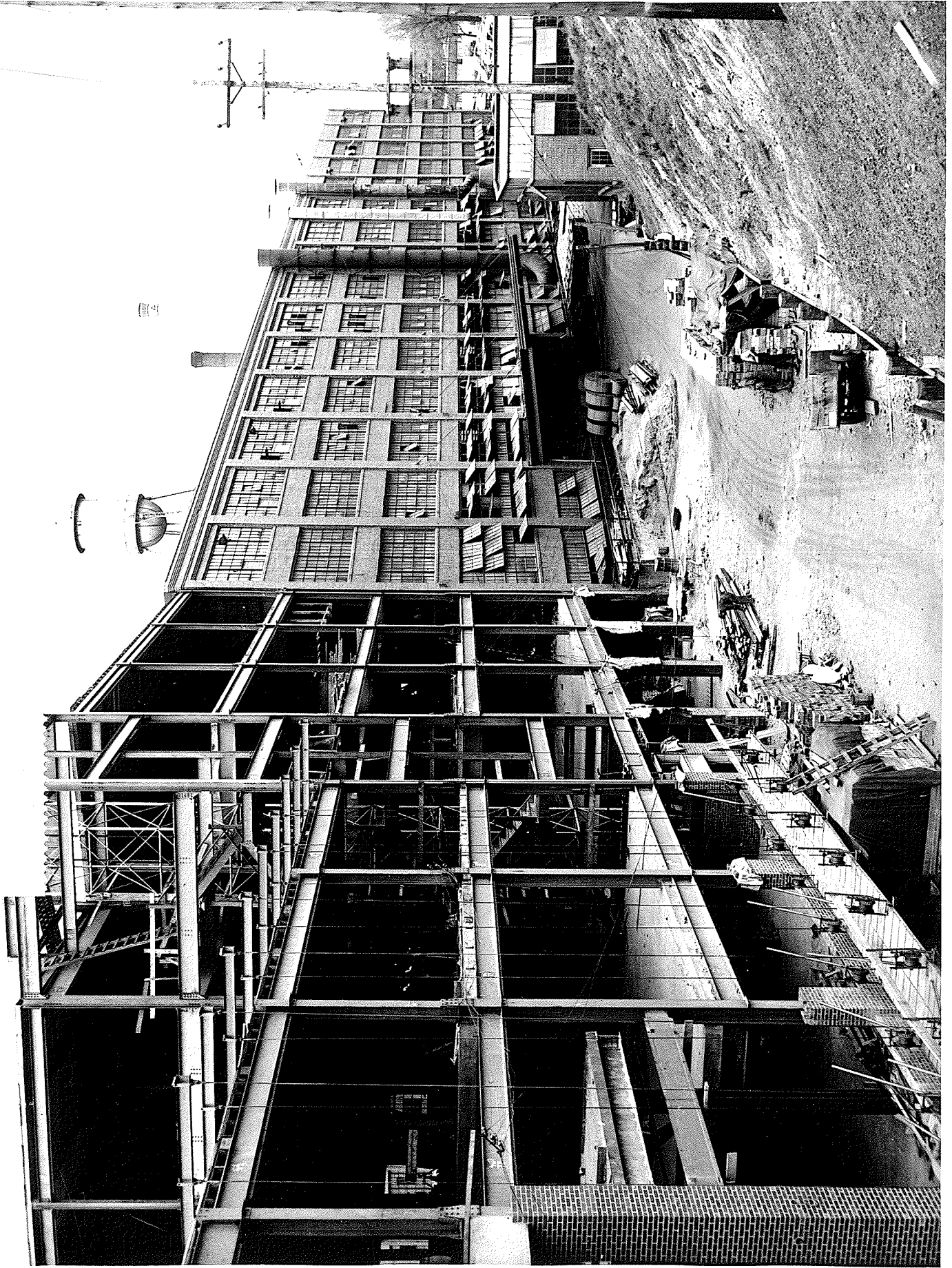
