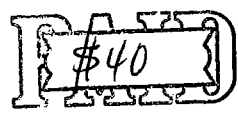



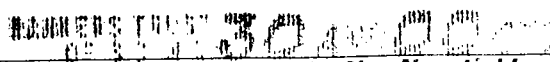

*Eligibility:* Every architect who is a legal resident of and has been granted a license or registration by any state, the District of Columbia, or any territory of the United States may apply for membership via the AIA chapter serving the area in which the architect lives or works.

*Rights/Privileges:* Upon admission to membership by the national AIA, the architect is entitled to all the rights and privileges which accompany membership and may proclaim this recognition by the use of the initials "AIA" or use of the title "Member of the American Institute of Architects."

*National Dues:* \$60 - 1st year; \$85 - 2nd year which begins January 1, following admission; \$130 - third and subsequent years. In addition, members who have ownership in firms are liable for supplemental dues the second year of membership. These dues are \$160 per registered architect in the firm minus \$90 per registered architect who is an AIA member.

When admitted during the last half of the calendar fiscal year, one-half of the annual dues paid with the application will be credited to next year's dues, except in situations in which a person is dropped and readmitted the same year.

*Local Dues/Assignment:* Upon admission, the member becomes a member of the national AIA, the local chapter and the state organization and is obligated for dues to each.


