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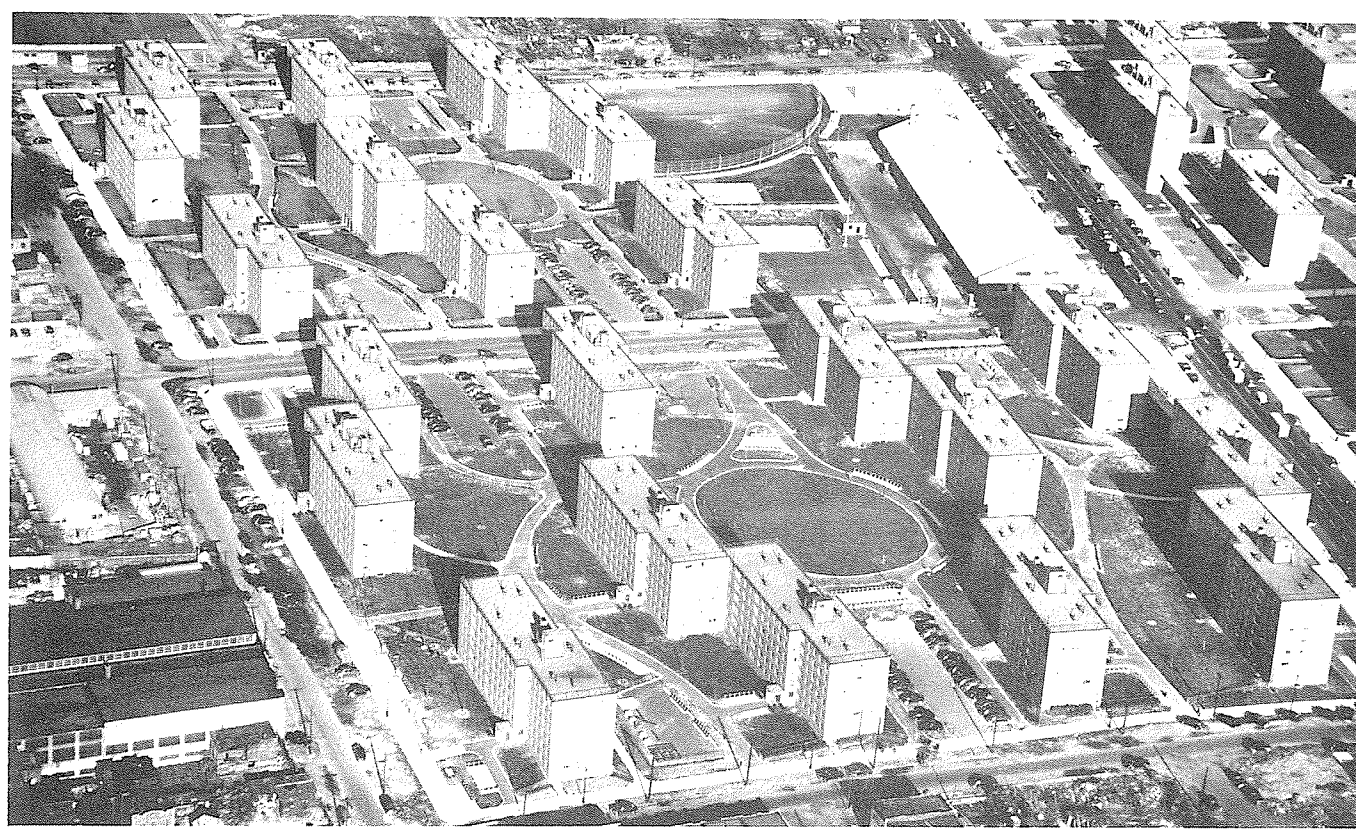

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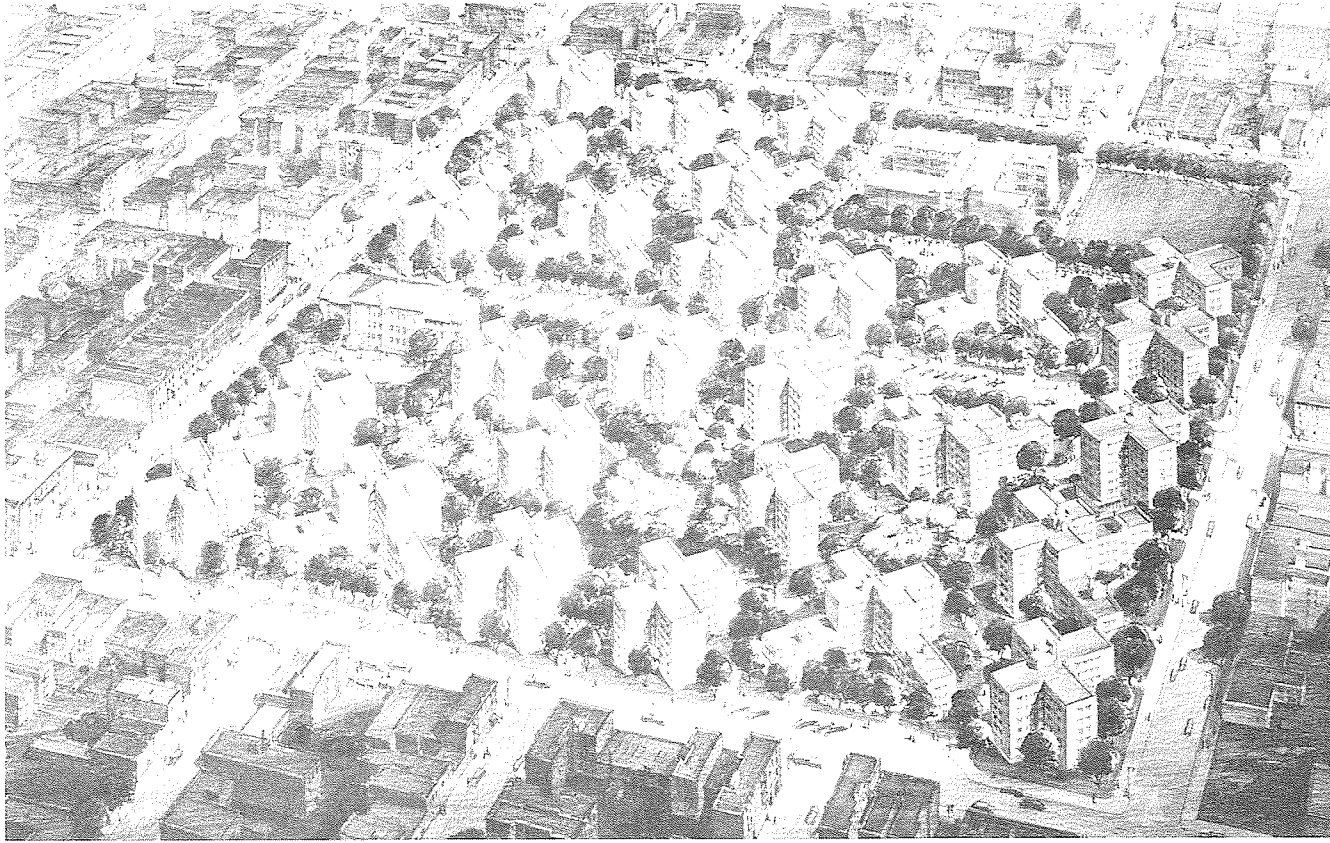


RAVENWOOD HOUSES



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BROWNSVILLE HOUSES

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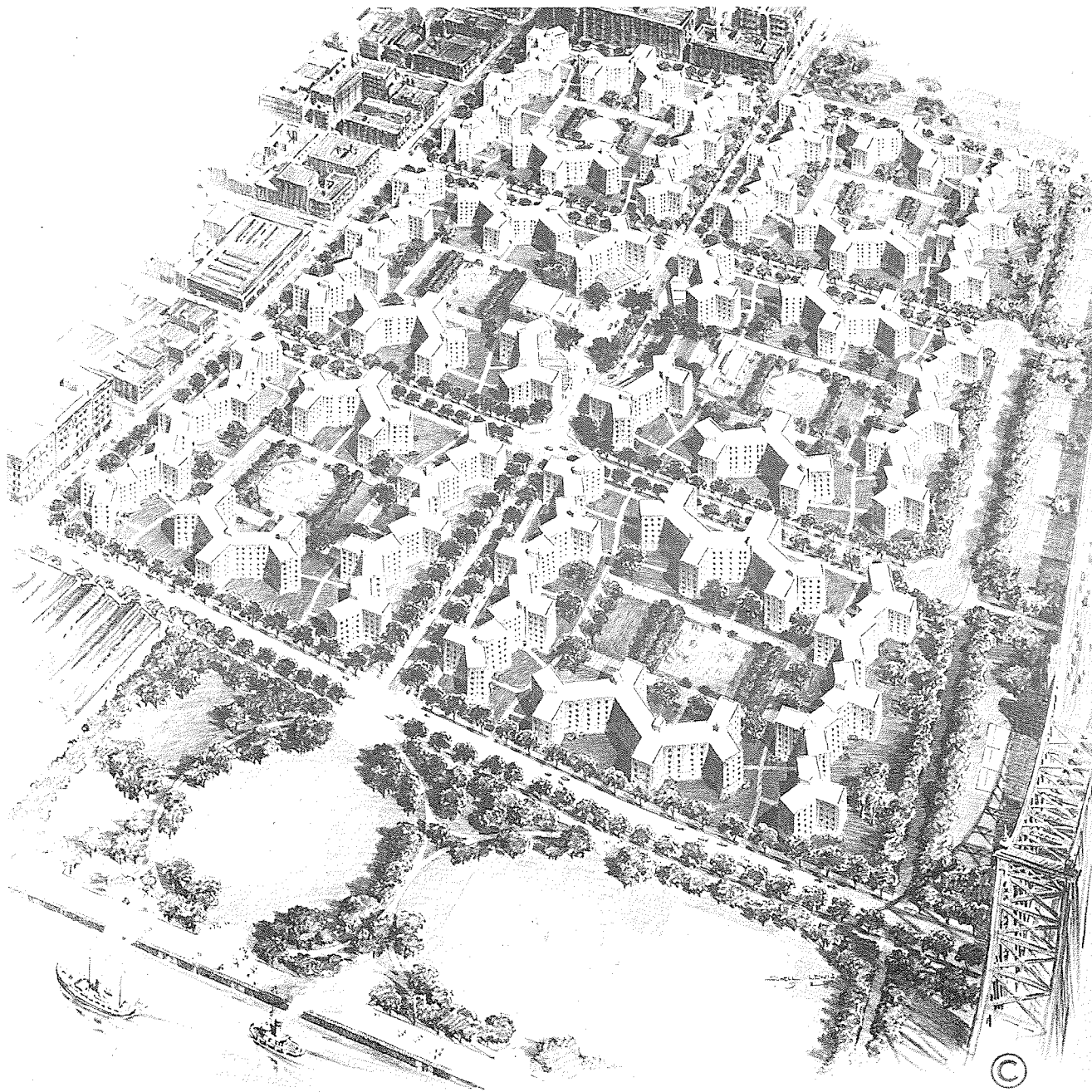

## WOOD GARDEN APARTMENT COMPETITION

### THE JURY REPORT

In judging this contest the Jury gave first consideration to the desirability of the apartments to tenants, to compact planning and to economical construction. These requirements were stressed in the competition program and are obviously essential for successful rental housing.

The Honorable Mention design by N.N. Culin, Architect, of New York City, a one story building of eight units, included a concise statement of the essential features of the problem and a clear presentation of the design.

Units are exceptionally well planned for privacy within the individual apartment. The extensive width of each unit and offset wall lines make possible front, and rear entrances on the north side of the building with a reasonable separation.



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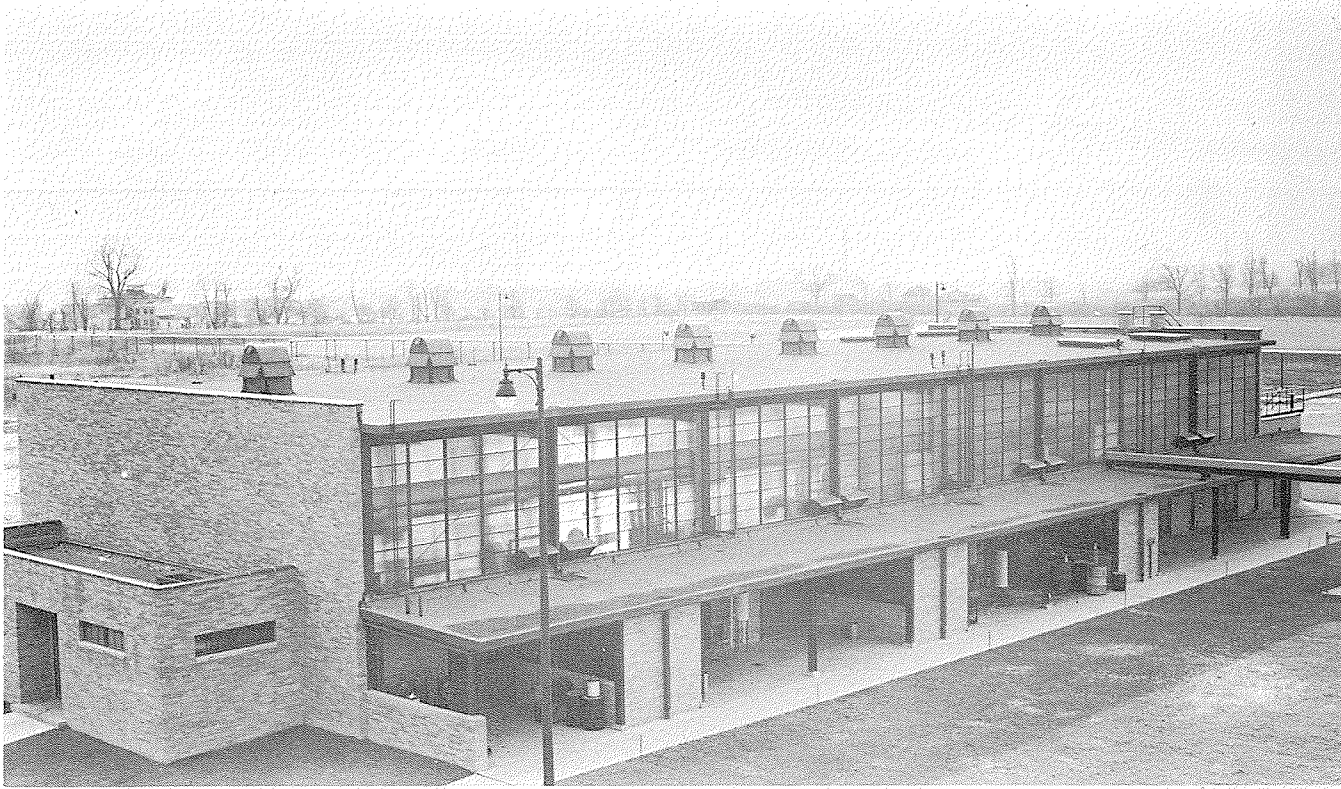
