This termination may be the result of your failure to understand the revised dues structure which requires full payment of AIA regular dues and supplemental dues (or statement of non-liability, if applicable) by April 20, 1979. It may also be the result of an administrative error on our part. If the latter reason should be the case, please contact our membership procedures department (202-785-7392).

In any case, we have valued your past membership in the Institute. We need you as part of AIA to help the profession continue to grow and prosper. At the same time, we are working hard to make more of the Institute's resources available through the AIA Hotline (202-785-5954), the annual AIA Journal Directory of Institute Programs and Services and the expanded AIA committee system. To effect this readmission, you need only pay your 1979 dues. A notice of your 1979 dues liability was mailed to you on March 15, 1979. There is no \$20 readmission fee if you renew your membership prior to May 31, 1979.
