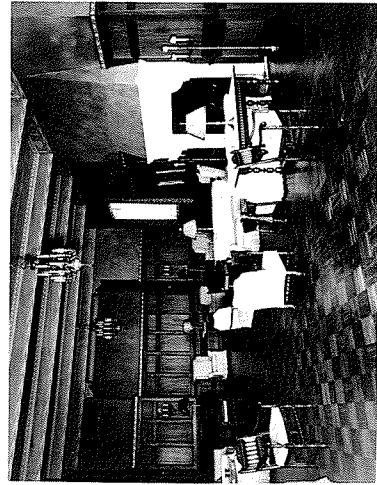
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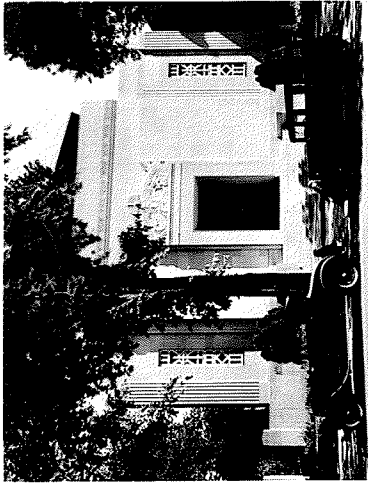

COST \$1,000,000 - OWNER - BROWNLEY ESTATE



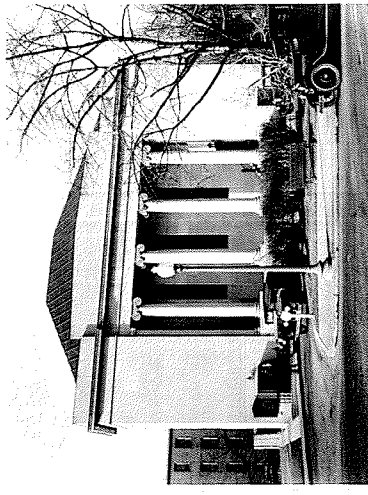
INTERIOR VIEW OF LOUNGE - DEERING - INSTITUTION



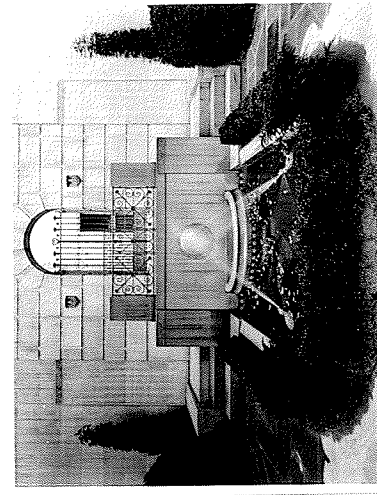
CHURCH OF THE EPIPHANY - WASH. D. C.

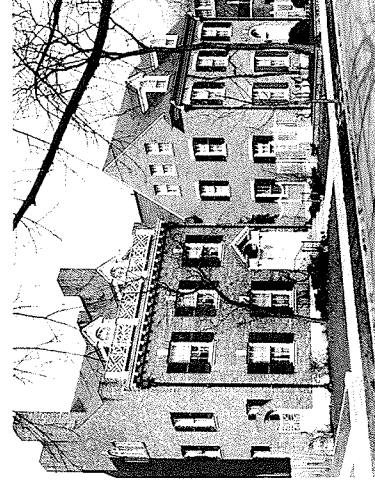

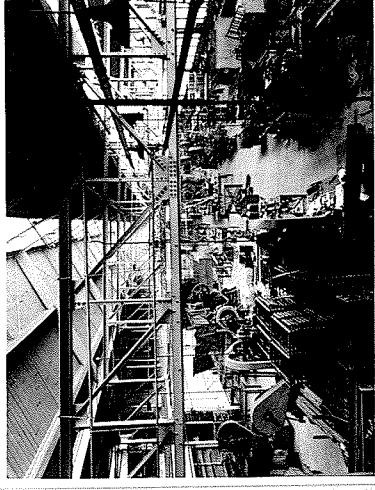
