

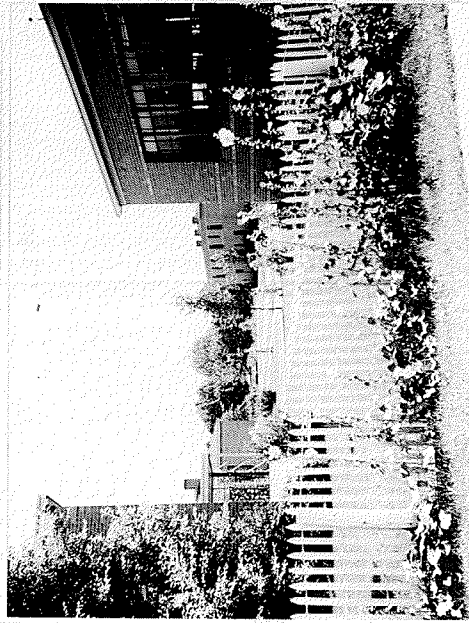

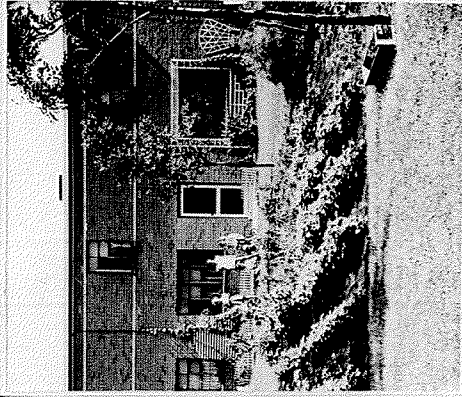

VIEW FROM GARDEN, NEARBY HOUSES, EAST SIDE OF NEW HOUSING PROJECT



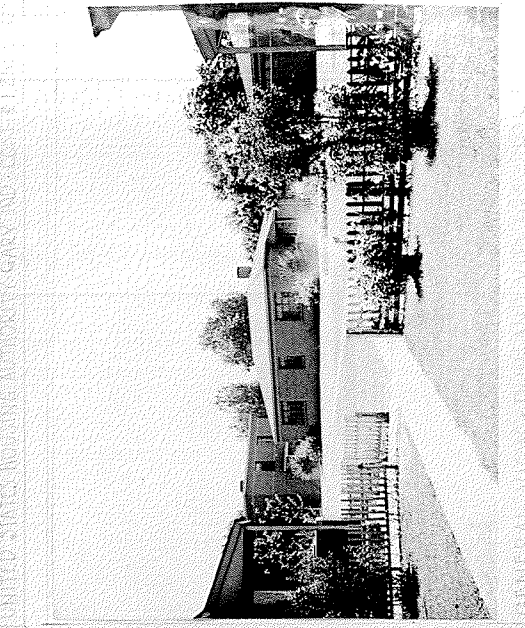

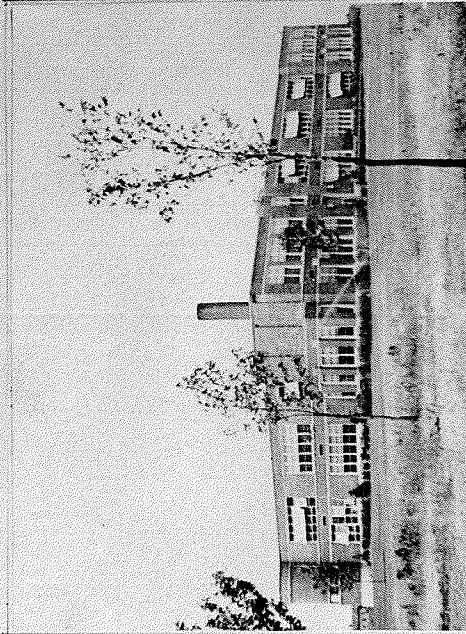

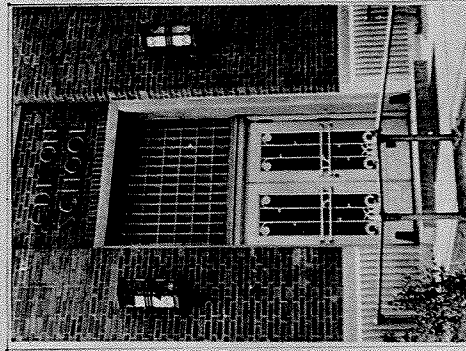

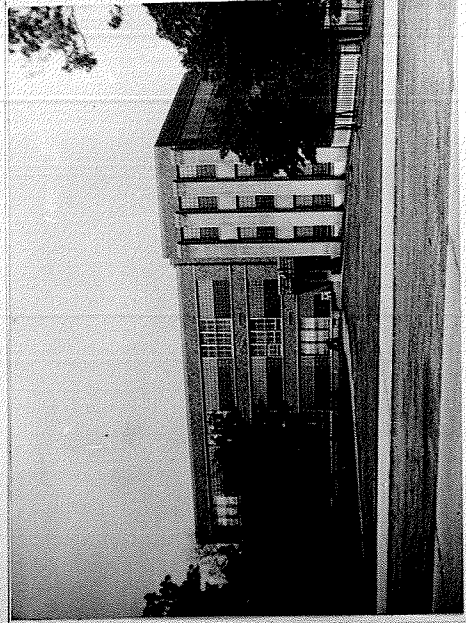

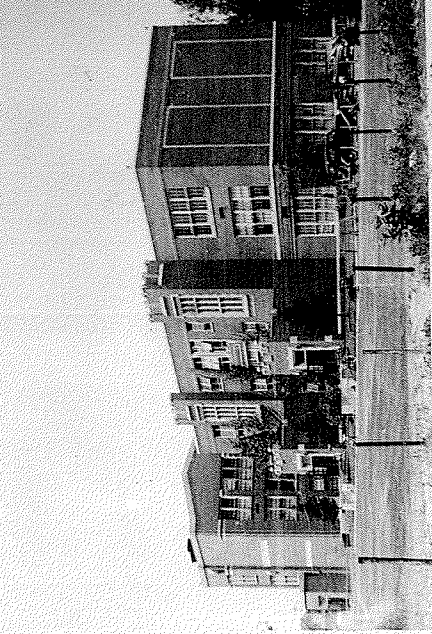

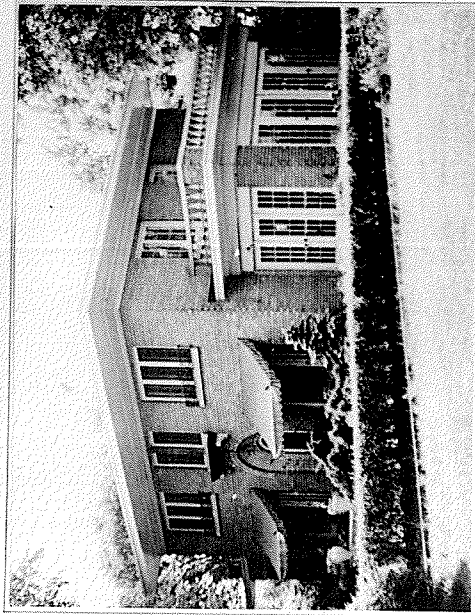

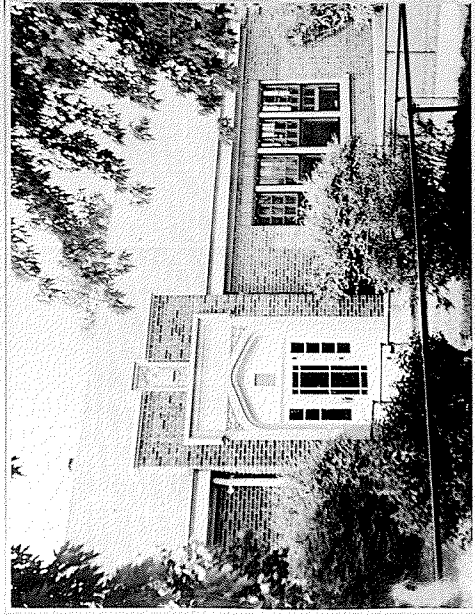
FRONT VIEW, STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION, INDIANAPOLIS, INDIANA. COST \$340,000

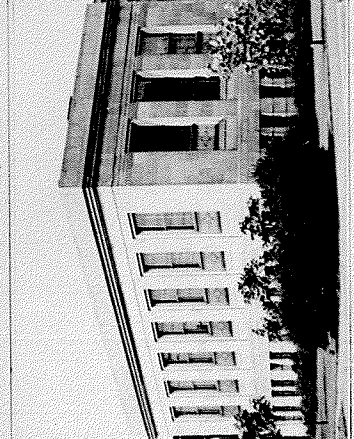
FRONT VIEW, THE COLLEGE LIBRARY, CITY OF GARY, IND. COST 25,000



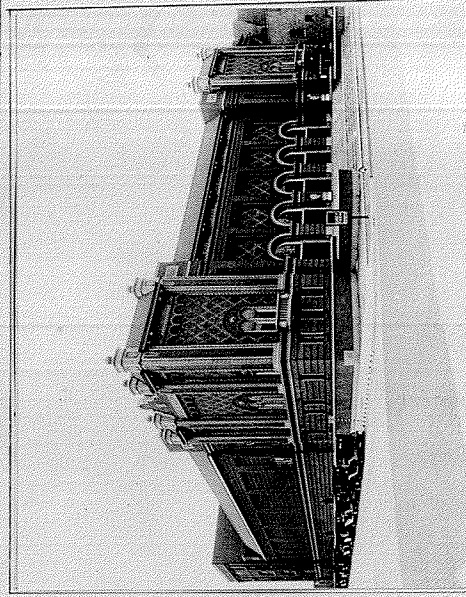

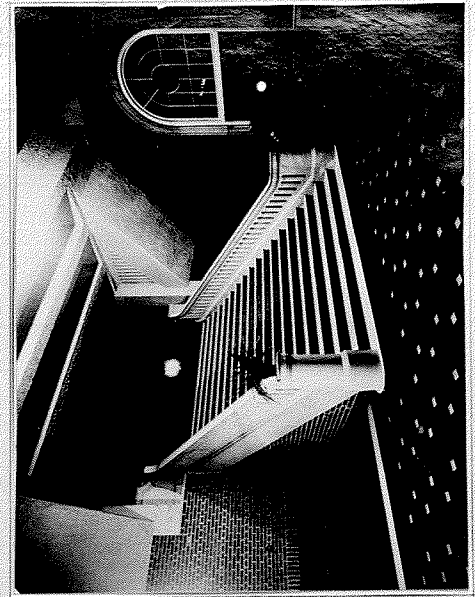
FRONT ENTRANCE, EAST SIDE LIBRARY, GARY PUBLIC LIBRARY, GARY, IND. COST 50,500

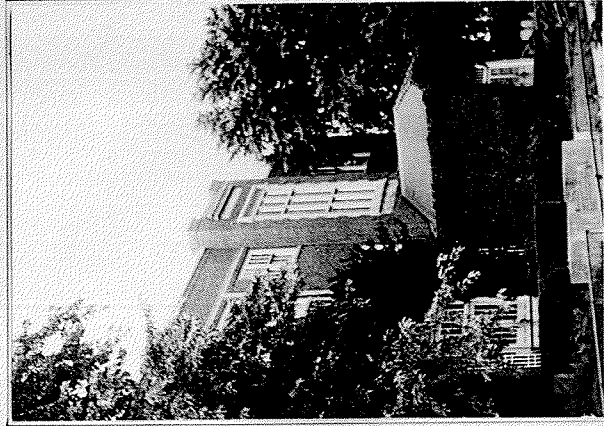

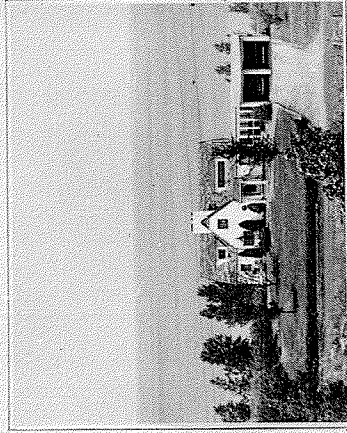
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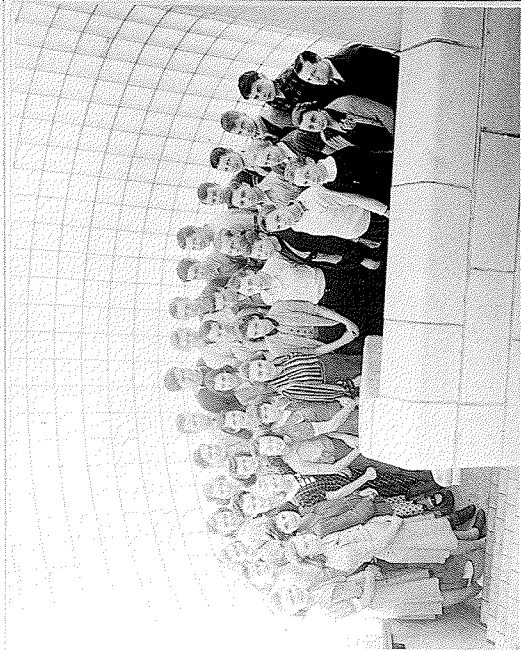
FRONT VIEW, GLEN PARK LIBRARY, GARY, INDIANA. COST \$60,000

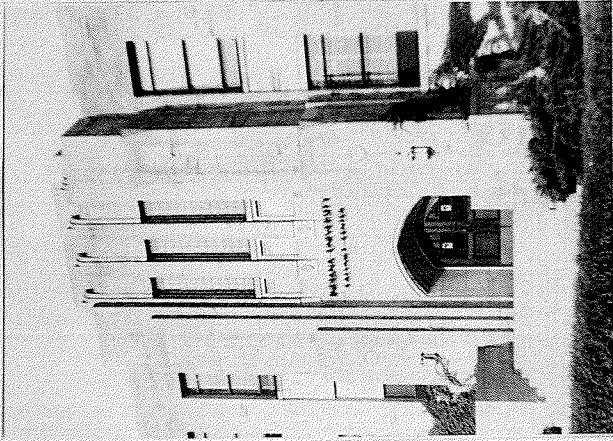

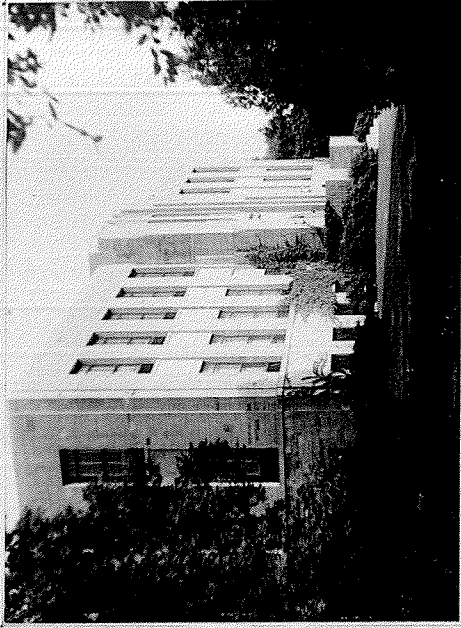
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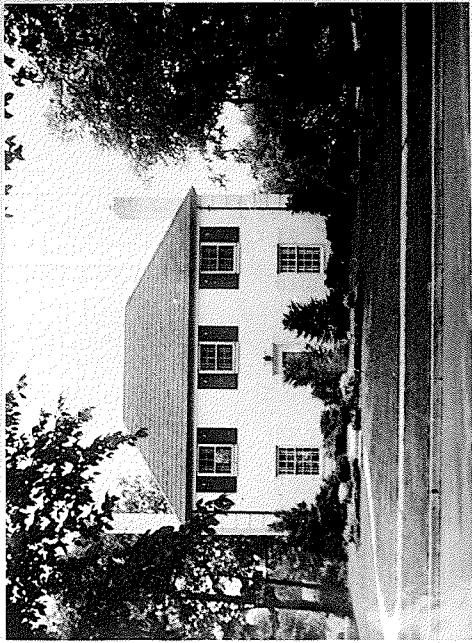
CLAY VIEW. UNIVERSITY OF INDIANA, CHICAGO. 1900. COST \$1,500,000.



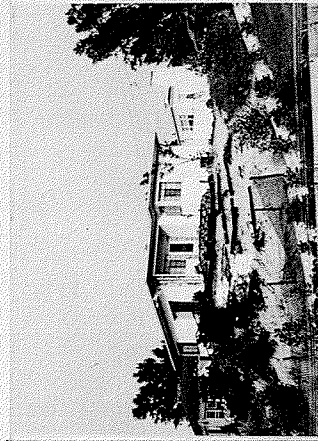
CLAY VIEW. CALUMET CENTER. UNIVERSITY OF INDIANA, EAST CHICAGO. COST \$50,000.



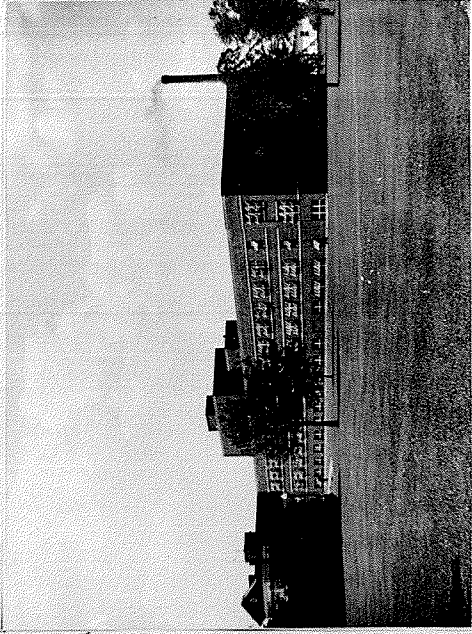
