

Since 1951, Karl Klokke's career has been centered in the Design Department of Albert C. Martin and Associates of Los Angeles, California. His role as Director of Design has been one of either direct responsibility for project design or that of giving inspiration and leadership to others who had the project design responsibility.

The most significant contributions Mr. Klokke has made to the profession are:

- 1. The development, from the beginning, of a systems approach to design, incorporating all the varied building ingredients into a cohesive design statement (Department of Water and Power Headquarters: Los Angeles, CA 1965).
- 2. Recognizing the importance of integrating the design of his buildings with their environment (Parker-Hannifin Headquarters, Engineering and Manufacturing Facilities: Irvine, CA 1970).
- 3. Pioneering the importance of interior design as an integral part of the overall design statement (St. Basil's Church: Los Angeles, CA 1969).
- 4. Employing a philosophy of order in architecture reflected in the careful detailing of all aspects of the building, the interiors and related areas such as plazas (Imperial Bank Office Building: Costa Mesa, CA 1979).
- 5. The conviction that significant works of all forms of art (including sculpture, fountains, etc.) enhance the architecture (Atlantic Richfield Plaza:
 Los Angeles, CA 1973).
- 6. Developing designs that conserve energy since the early 1960's (TRW Systems, Inc. Research, Development and Manufacturing Center: Redondo Beach, CA 1966). Currently he is pioneering new concepts in energy conservation in several high-rise buildings now under construction.
- 7. The building of a high quality design staff with each designer able to express his own philosophy.

Mr. Klokke has personally designed and/or supervised the design of many award-winning structures, several of which have become landmarks in their community.
