IgCC and ASHRAE Standard 189.1

- ICC and ASHRAE have decided to work together to fully combine IgCC and Standard 189.1
- As it has since the IgCC's creation in 2009, AIA will continue to play a key role in this evolution so that it reflects the perspective of the practicing architect

IgCC and ASHRAE Standard 189.1

- This change will be supportive of our One Code Policy & our position statement on codes/standards/rating systems
- We anticipate that this change will affect the code no sooner than the 2018 version of the IgCC; the 2015 edition will be published next spring

IgCC and ASHRAE Standard 189.1

- AIA staff, C&S committee, and expert volunteers will be fully engaged in:
 - Technical content development
 - ICC/ASHRAE joint steering committee
 - Managing relationships w/important allies
 - Communications w/members & components

IgCC 2015 – Next Steps

- Major takeaways from May 2014 Committee Action Hearings in Memphis
- Next steps:
 - July 16: Public comments due to ICC
 - Oct. 1-5: Public Comment Hearings (Florida)
 - Oct. 15-29: Online member voting on final actions through cdpACCESS

IgCC 2015 – Next Steps

- Focus public comments on acceptable code change proposals the ICC committee voted to disapprove
- SEHPCAC has discussed several important items for public comment, to which AIA will consider co-signing

IgCC 2015 – Proposal Highlights

- **GG320:** Essentially removes energy provisions and reverts to 2012 IECC; the ICC committee disapproved this, but a floor motion was held to approve this
- Need strong AIA comment in opposition, highlighting the need for a strong 2015 IgCC in light of future 189.1 merger

IgCC 2015 – Proposal Highlights

- **GG68:** Resolve conflicting vegetative roof language
- **GG102:** Soil definition language needs clarification
- **GG138:** Affects placement of construction waste language
- **GG26:** Changes reference standards adoption requirement
- **GG31:** Deletes mixed occupancy building requirement
- **GG319:** Deletes project electives
- *Other proposals affecting zEPI*

ANSI A117.1 – Update

- Mobility Task Group Update
- Meeting July 14-16
- Scoping
- Existing Buildings

2018 ICC Codes – Group A Code Cycle

- **Group A (2015)** includes IBC (non-structural), IEBC, IFGC, IPC, IMC, IRC
- Code change proposals accepted through cdpACCESS
 - begins 11/15/14; deadline 1/12/15
- Hearings in spring and autumn 2015

2018 ICC Codes – Other Code Cycles

- **Group A (2015)** includes IBC (non-structural), IEBC, IFGC, IPC, IMC, IRC
- **Group B (2016)** includes: IBC (structural), IECC (com. and res.), IFC
- **Group C (2017)** includes: IgCC
