Judging Criteria

Entries must demonstrate excellence in function, both in its original form and by today's standards.

The jury will examine the building and site and will take into consideration any alteration to the immediate context.

Eligibility

Entrants:

- AIA chapters, Knowledge Communities, and members may submit nominations

Projects:

- must have been completed between 1982 and 1992
- must have been designed by a U.S.-licensed architect at the time of the project's completion
- must be in a substantially completed form, in good condition, and not fundamentally altered from its original intent

Entries must include:

- a one-page nomination statement by the sponsor
- a 500-word project description, including the site and appearance at the time of submission
- a brief outline of any transformations
- a 500-word description of sustainable design strategies and innovations
- project images that indicate original and current conditions in a single PDF file, 10 MB and 26 pages max

- project images must be submitted in a single .PDF file not to exceed **10 MB** and a maximum of 26 pages
- when possible, images should include the building in use and the following in any order to best tell the jury your project's story:
 1. a one-page nomination statement by the sponsoring AIA member, group of members, component, or AIA knowledge community
 2. a minimum of four images to properly illustrate the project in its original condition
 3. a minimum of two images of the project in its current condition
 4. site and floor plans (to properly illustrate the project in its original condition)
 5. site and floor plans of intervening changes, if any, to assist the jury in its evaluation

Additional Tips

- composite pages are acceptable
- text/notes on images/drawings are allowed
- indicate the scale used on any drawings or plans
- consistent use of either a horizontal or portrait landscape is encouraged throughout the submission
