2017 AIA Honorary Membership

Members of the AIA Board of Directors, Strategic Coucil, chapters, or Knowledge Communities may submit nominations.

Eligibility

Nominees must <u>not</u> be eligible for membership in the Institute, including individuals who:

- are eligible by education or experience and are employed, enrolled or participating in circumstances recognized by licensing authorities as constituting credit toward architectural licensure, or
- are employed under the supervision of an architect in a professional or technical capacity directly related to the practice of architecture,
- have a professional degree in architecture, or are faculty members in university programs in architecture and who are actively involved in research, administration, or the teaching of architecture, or
- · have an architectural license or the equivalent from a non-U.S. licensing authority and demonstrate honorable standing in the profession in the locale in which they are licensed

Institute and component staff members may be nominated for Honorary Membership during their employment after:

- they have completed a cumulative total of ten years as employees of the Institute and/or one or more components
- such employment need not be continuous
- the Secretary may waive all or part of the period of employment if an individual may be eligible for nomination for reasons other than his or her employment as an Institute or component staff member

Because the Jury must rely solely on the submission to speak for the achievements of the nominees, great responsibility lies with the nominator and references of the nominee. The nominators should feel certain that the nominee's achievements have sufficient distinction to make them notable contributions to the advancement of the profession or its allied arts and sciences. They should remember that the age, personality, and popularity of the nominee do not, of themselves, constitute a notable contribution, and Honorary Membership is not an award for the nominee's industry or success.

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

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SUBMISSION UPLOAD FOR JURY REVIEW

Submit supporting documentation in a single .PDF file - max 10 MB not to exceed 32 pages - and include:

- 1. nomination letter (one page) from the sponsor (the regional director must be notified of any nomination made in their area.)
- 2. the candidate's professional activities and accomplishments that constitute distinguished service to the profession of architecture or to the arts and sciences allied therewith (max of two pages)
- 3. the candidate's professional activities and accomplishments that constitute distinguished service to the Institute (max of two
- 4. all other qualifications (honors, awards, publications, positions held, etc. max of two pages)
- 5. other exhibits (max of 15 pages) as appropriate to support the nomination (photographs, brochures, booklets, etc.)
- 6. a minimum of seven to a maximum of ten one-page letters of support that are explicit in their recommendation and contain specific reasons supporting the candidate's nomination (the one page letter is to be written on company letterhead and signed)

A second upload for your headshot using the following parameters is required:

• a digital photo/image (head shot or portrait) at least 1200 pixels wide by 600 pixels tall and between 72 - 150 DPI of the candidate in .JPEG format no larger than 5 MB and labeled as "LastName_FirstName"

This image will be used for announcement purposes.

External links to documents are an acceptable method of supplying additional material should you feel it is significant and vital for the jury to examine, but they are not required to review these items.
