By the numbers

AIA Members

605 AIA members participated in meetings with their Senators and Representatives.

- They came from 48 states and 3 US Territories
- They came from 360 congressional districts, or 83% of the nation's congressional districts
- They came from 96 Senate districts

Hill Meetings

474 meetings were held in the House and the Senate.

- 137 meetings were with Members of Congress
- 205 meetings were with senior level staff (Chief of Staff, Legislative Director or a committee staff member)
- 132 meetings were with junior staff

Targeted Committees

AIA targeted eight committees that are critical to the 2019 legislative agenda for special attention:

- Senate
 - Energy and Natural Resources
 - Health, Education, Labor, and Pensions
 - Homeland Security and Governmental Affairs
 - Finance
- House
 - Energy and Commerce

 - Homeland Security
 - Ways and Means

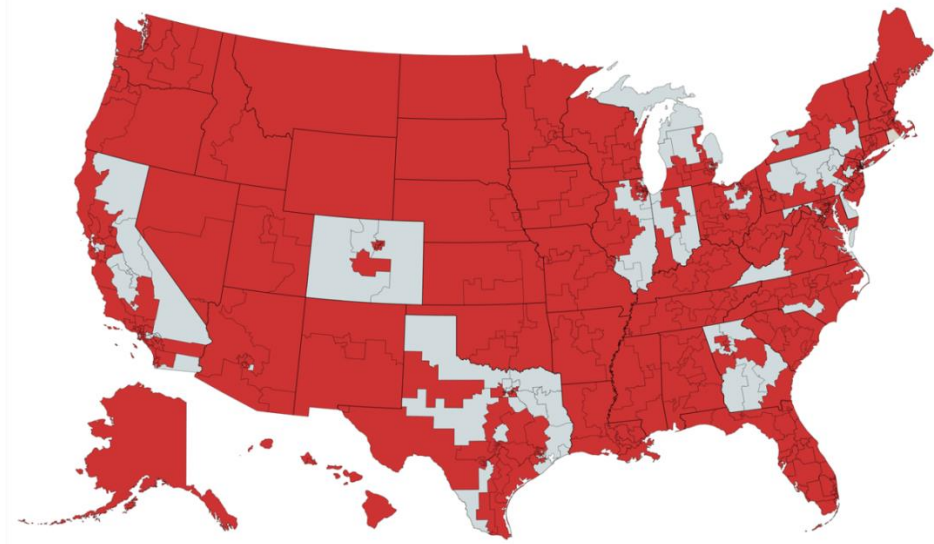

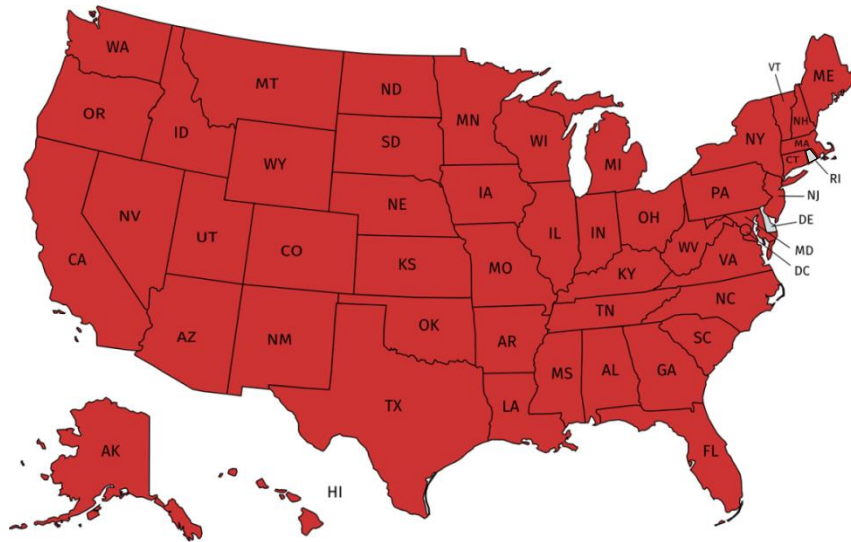
Out of a possible 237 targets, AIA members met with Members of Congress or their staff from 217 offices, or 92% of targeted Members of Congress.

Virtual Capitol Hill Day
