

Dear Mr. Andrew:

By unanimous vote, the Board agreed to waive your 1974 dues and to request that National do the same.

In accord with Board policy, this waiver is granted only for one year. Should your hardships continue next year and another waiver is needed, it is necessary that you petition us again and outline specific reasons for the waiver. If the waiver is granted, it would only apply to that year's financial obligation.

If a waiver is needed for the third year, the policy is that if it is granted it would be on the condition that a resignation be submitted. The reason for this is that when the individual returns to the Institute he would have no financial obligation to the Chapter and would resign as a member in good standing.
