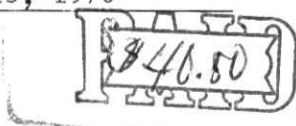

Barbara Wolfe Siemens, 88, died peacefully at her home, in Carrollton, Texas, on October 19, 2010, after a long illness.

Born June 20, 1922 in Fremont, Ohio, she was the second daughter of Col. Stanley Wolfe (deceased) and Margaret (Bowlus) Wolfe (deceased). Barbara attended Ohio State University where she received her BA in Architecture in 1945. She began her practice as an architect in 1946 in Fremont, Ohio and was an active member of the American Institute of Architects (AIA).

She married Miros Siemens, Jr. in 1946 and they moved to Lafayette, Indiana in 1950. The couple purchased a home on North River Road in 1951, which they dubbed "Sycamore Springs" and resided there for 42 years. Barbara worked as an architect for H. Stewart Kline & Associates, a design firm in Lafayette for over twenty years, retiring in 1992. She designed numerous commercial and residential buildings in the Lafayette and West Lafayette area. Barbara was a member of Blessed Sacrament Church in West Lafayette, Indiana. She was involved in Special Olympics, the Wabash Center and other services for the handicapped, including building design to aid the handicapped. In 2008, due to declining health, Barbara moved to Carrollton, TX, to reside with her daughter, Teresa.

Eldest son, Craig Stephen, died Aug. 3, 2010 in Austin, TX. Surviving are seven children: Lucinda Siemens Foulke of Elmhurst, IL (husband: Richard), Teresa (Siemens) King of Dallas, TX (husband Bradford, deceased), Nicholas A. Siemens of Austin, TX (wife: Barbara), Clarissa A. M. Siemens (Ricardo Monterrosa) of Los Angeles, CA, Mark D. M. Siemens of Austin, TX, Claudia P. Siemens of Lafayette, IN and Eugenia Fair of Lafayette, IN (husband: Alex).

Also surviving are 13 grandchildren: Brion Foulke, Lauren Foulke, Merryn F. Young (husband, Jason), Nicholas King, Peter King, Katherine King, Jack King, Anthony Mullis, Camden Mullis, Baily Fair, Garrett Fair, Riley Bush and Greg Bush and great grandchild, Kayley Bush.
