His strong and beign influence for excellence in design has been effective far beyond his own personal work.

For many years he was the one man Jury or Board of Architectural Control for Santa Anita Caks, a choice residential community, developed on the eastern edge of Pasadena, California.

From the 1920-s until World War II, with Palmer Sabin and Me, and subsequently Ralph Flewelling, he was an active and very effective member of the Architectural Jury for Emerald Bay, a fine quality residential community on the Pacific Coast near Laguna, California.
