Equity: Foster equity, diversity, and a sense of belonging within the profession, and advance the health, safety and welfare of our communities through design and advocacy for lasting solutions in our built environments.

REVOLUTIONIZE
Research and technology: Leverage emerging technologies and social science to accelerate architecture's progression from knowledge-driven discipline and evidence-based, transform solutions. Harness an intra/entrepreneurial start-up mentality to foster rapid innovation.
Architectural education: Make architectural education more responsive to emerging trends, more inclusive of underserved audiences, and more oriented toward the future role of the architect.

Equity, Diversity & Inclusion Overview

- **Dismantle barriers within all AIA systems:** governance, honors and awards, internal policies, vendor selection, hiring/retention, and any business practice that intentionally or unintentionally contributes to injustice and exclusion (policies, practices, and programs).
- **Expand inclusiveness and diversity within the profession through K-12 and higher education** engagements and advocating for effective pathways into the profession. Expand the participation of racially and ethnically diverse populations, women, and other underrepresented groups.
- **Conduct training, enhance education** and knowledge dissemination, and increase the number of high-quality new resources for the Board, staff, volunteers, and members.
- **Develop stronger connections to bridge workforce, climate action, and equitable communities' priorities** in alignment with the 2021-2025 Strategic Plan.

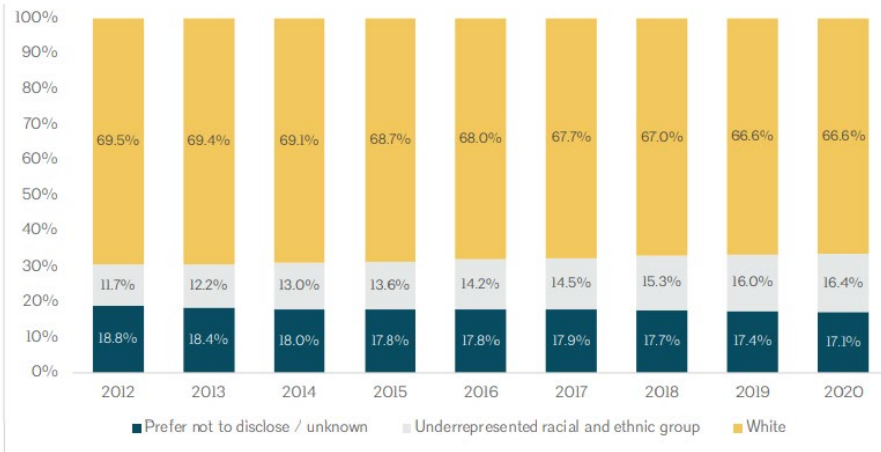
Equity, Diversity & Inclusion Partnership Opportunities

- **Reach out and Engage with Schools of Architecture** - they need your members and firms for juries, teaching, mentors and more.
- **Obtain Component Matching Grants:** AIA matches scholarships for students up to \$1,000 provided by an AIA component to a NAAB-accredited programs (undergraduate and graduate). AIA will match up to \$500 for a student enrolled at a technical or community college architecture program.
- **Educate members on the Guides for Equitable Practice**, which provide key insights to help individuals, firms, and other organizations build equity in architecture.
- **Align and engage component EDI committees** with the work of Equity and the Future of Architecture Committee.

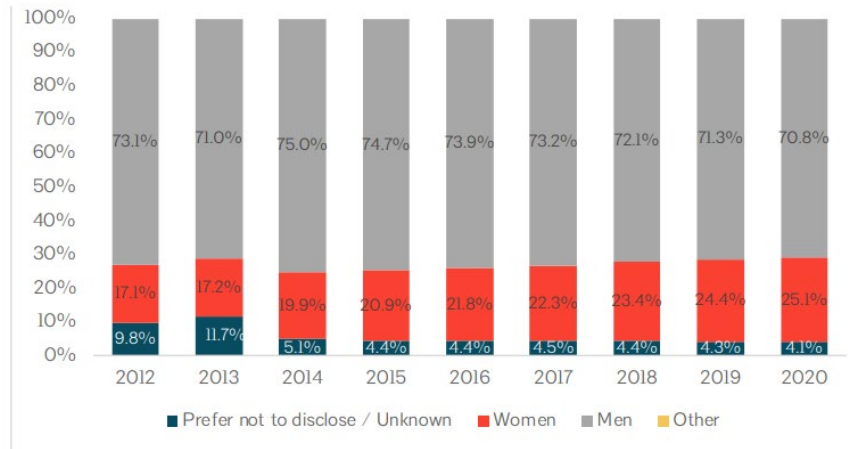


Membership Demographics Report 2020
