Stepping Back in Time – the 9-5

Invented by American labor unions in the 1800s

Made mainstream by Henry Ford in the 1920s

Ford noticed tired employees made more mistakes (FACTORIES)

Fair Labor Standards Act limited working hours for all – signed in 1938

Practice transitioned with the workforce transition to offices

Centralize equipment – typewriters, switchboards, fax machines

Productivity and punch cards
